

#### 4. Ruhpolding – Marzoll

Length of Stage: ca. 36 km

Total Climbs: 390 m

From the tourist information center, we will make a right along the main road. At the roundabout, we take the second exit following signs for “Gemeindewerke/Rettungsdienste”, which will take us onto Waldbahnstraße. At the first left-hand bend, we make a right across a former railway bridge, passing to the right of the indoor tennis center and the tennis courts, which will bring us to Zellerstraße. We cross this via the Eglbrücke bridge, then follow the bike path on the right bank of the Traun until this comes to a small service road with parking spaces. Here we make a left, crossing the bridge over the Traun before making an immediate right once more and following a small stream, crossing three smaller roads as we make our way through the golf course. At the end of the golf course, a paved road begins just beyond a bridge, finally bringing us to the Zellerstraße. We make a left on this, then take a quick right towards “Infang/Rabenmoos”. The paved road ends after about 2 km, followed by a beautiful forestry road alongside a small stream and taking us down through the forest to the Oberhausen farms. Aside from these interesting farmsteads, we will also have beautiful views of the Froschsee and the Rauschberg which towers up behind it.

We now get to enjoy a more leisurely ride, making a left along a paved road, passing the Kesselalm, until we reach Innzell. After Vorderbichl, we make a left on Schmelzer Straße, which will take us into town. We turn left onto Trausteiner Straße and make a right at the bus station, continuing through the underpass and onto Schwimmbadstraße. At the swim center, we first turn left onto Lärchenstraße, then right onto Kreuzfeldstraße, before then making a left up the mountain towards the Brenner and a right to Teisenberg. We now cycle downhill, turning left at the bottom onto Adlgaßerstraße. This paved road now takes us for about 1.5 km to Adlgaß (site of an inn and a large car park). In Adlgaß (car park), we keep straight (path No. 13) to the Inzeller Höhe (about a 1 km climb) and continue straight ahead following signs for Anger. After travelling for about 3 km into the valley, passing the Kohlhäusl forestry service hut along the way, we will reach the Kohlhäusl car park. From here, we take the paved road (slightly downhill, 3 km) until we get to Anger. Shortly after the sign for the entrance to town, we take a right onto Scheiterstraße, making yet another right after about 200 m onto Anger Straße. From here, we follow the marked bike path via Aufham (2 km) to Piding (5 km); at the autobahn onramp just before Piding, we ride underneath Salzburger Straße and follow the bike path alongside the Pidinger Ache. This same path takes us under the autobahn and then to some railway tracks, where we make another right, which will bring us to a railway crossing with a turnstile. After the railway crossing, we will head briefly downhill to our right, continue straight through the Au, take a pedestrian bridge across the Saalach, then continue straight through the Au once again until we come to the Reichenhaller Straße underpass. After the underpass, we will make a half-left onto a road leading through the fields to Türk. After about 250 m, we will turn left and ride towards Marzoll, with the church and striking Schloss Marzoll constantly before our eyes.
